On completion of your degree you could work as an adult educator, an instructional designer, an education officer or an education advisor. Due to the diverse nature of the degree students could continue to further study in the areas of training, development and education. They may also apply for the Primary Masters in Education (PME, a further 2 years) in MIE or elsewhere.

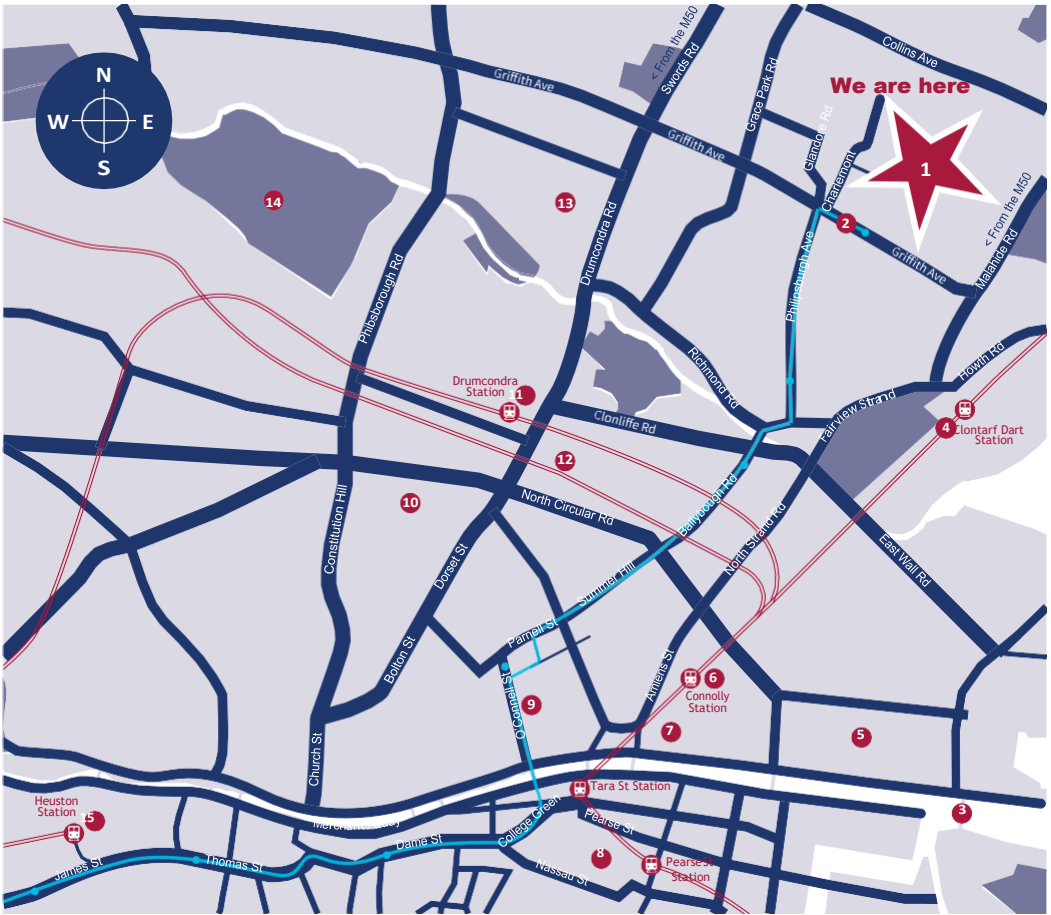
